This information from General Motors should assist you as a final stage vehicle manufacturer of 2014 XTS Cadillac professional vehicles equipped with the W30, V4U or B9Q options.

The issues addressed are:

- 1) Federal fuel economy of converted vehicles
- 2) Determination of applicable gas-guzzler taxes
- 3) Emission certification of converted vehicles

The following information is from General Motors' Emission and Fuel Economy Certification Testing of Data Vehicles simulating conversions of 2014, 3.6L Cadillac professional vehicles at different inertia weight classes. The vehicles have been certified to Federal and California emission standards (see attachments).
