This bulletin was recently updated to reflect model year coverage of 2012 - 2017

Condition:

Reported Water Intrusion into the Passenger Compartment on Caprice PPVs following the addition of special equipment to which the water deflector has been removed to gain access to the inside of the door.

Recommendation:

To eliminate the possibility of water intrusion into the vehicle passenger compartment, the steps on the following pages should be followed when removing and re-installing the door water deflector(s).

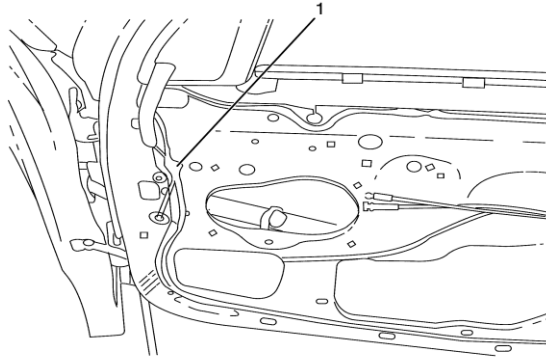

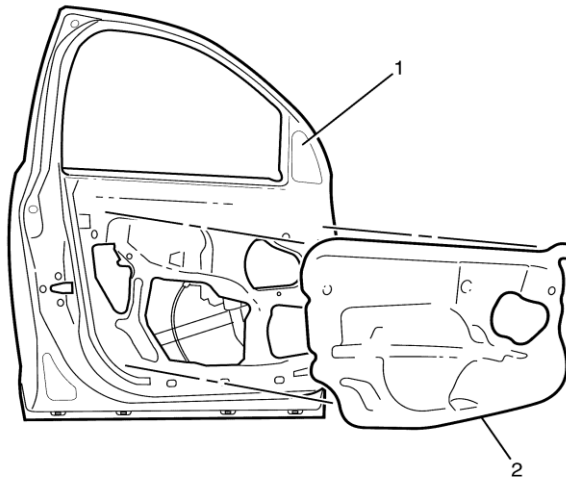


Removal Procedure

1. Remove the door trim panel.
2. Remove the speaker.



3. Detach the wiring harness to door retaining clip (1).



4. Remove the water deflector (2) from the door (1).

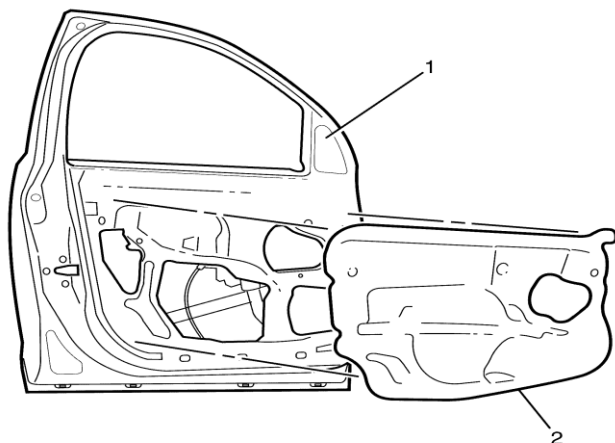
Important: Pull the water deflector (2) from the door (1) to release the adhesive bond.

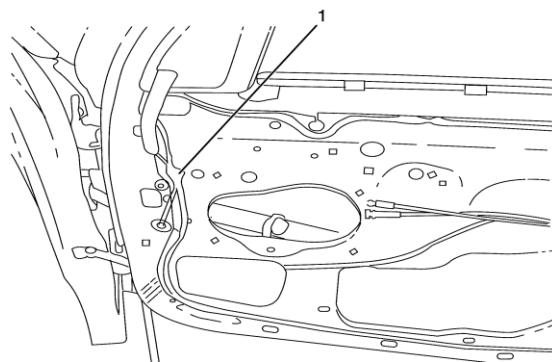
Installation Procedure



1. Install the water deflector (2) to the door (1).

Important: Firmly press the water deflector (2) where adhesive is applied to make sure of a water tight seal to the door (1).

NOTE: For higher level of assurance of a complete seal...a hand held roller is recommended to increase the "wet-out" of the adhesive between the surfaces of the deflector and the door.



2. Attach the wiring harness to door retaining clip (1).
3. Install the speaker.
4. Install the door trim panel.
