Condition/Concern:

The purpose of this bulletin is to advise upfitters of the requirement(s) to mount the rear axle vent hose in its designated location to prevent water intrusion into the rear axle differential case.

Repair/Recommendation:




Figure 1 (example)

Chassis Cabs and ZW9 Box delete vehicles are shipped with the rear axle vent tube coiled and secured to the frame (see example in Figure 1)

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When installing filler neck assembly on a service body be sure to route and secure the rear axle vent tube in the location shown in Figure 2.



Additional Information:
