Subject: New Alignment Specifications for W30 Extended Sedan

Based on feedback we have received regarding the sensitivity to tire wear issues with the current W30 Professional Vehicle, there has been a specification change that effects 4-wheel alignment.

The alignment tolerance for camber on the W30 has been revised. The new tolerance is +/-0.5 which is tighter than the original +/-0.8. See chart below. It is very important that you share this new information with your servicing dealers so that they understand the new requirement.
